

Morris Multiplex – Facility Protocols, Covid-19 Updated February 2021

All staff, instructors, spectators and users are required to complete the self-screening questionnaire prior to entering the facility. The questionnaire can be found online at <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/>

All users MUST adhere to the current Public Health Orders:

- Only one-on-one instruction is allowed at this time.
- Each person receiving instruction is accompanied by an instructor who is solely responsible for providing instruction to that person
- The total number of instructors and persons receiving instruction does not exceed 12 (25% of the usual capacity for the area)
- No more than one person for each person receiving instruction is permitted to enter the facility to observe the instruction.

General Rules:

- Physical distancing of 2 meters (6 feet) is required inside the facility – both on and off the ice.
- Masks are required AT ALL TIMES with the exception of on ice training
- Ice capacity is clearly marked throughout the facility
- All users must follow designated pathways as marked
- Participants are asked to stay in the assigned dressing room until their scheduled ice time
- Congregating or waiting in hallways and common areas is not permitted
- Showers are not to be used at this time
- Water fountains are not available at this time
- Only one parent / guest per participant is permitted
- High contact surfaces and dressing rooms are cleaned and sanitized after each ice session
- Dryland training is not permitted inside the facility

Arrival & Building Exit

- Upon arrival, all persons are required to use hand sanitizer provided.
- Participants will have access to the facility 15 minutes before their scheduled ice time.
- All users will be asked to sign in
- Participants are asked to exit the facility 15 minutes after their session through marked doors

The Morris Multiplex is not responsible for any fines incurred by users or spectators not following the current Provincial guidelines/Public Health Orders.

Any user found not complying with the above stated protocols or any of the Public Health Acts applicable to the facility will be asked to leave immediately, with no refund issued.
